Priority #2:

An environment that supports opportunities for all learners to succeed.

Goal A:

We will provide targeted services for all students to meet their individual needs so all students can succeed.

- 1. Continue to push for more inclusive educational opportunities for all students, such as; Special Education, Title programs, Gifted and Talented, English Learners, At-Risk, etc.
- 2. Ongoing teacher trainings for common and formative assessments to help measure student's abilities for their success.
- 3. Achieve a consistent Problem Solving Team philosophy in all four schools of the district.

Goal B:

We will develop well-rounded students by providing a variety of quality Co-curricular opportunities.

- 1. Increase opportunities in academics, arts, and athletic programs through-out all grade levels in all buildings.
- 2. Find more training for leaders and coaches of these programs.
- 3. We will initiate a systematic program evaluation process for these programs.
- 4. Continue to search for more opportunities for co-curricular activities at the middle school level.

Goal C:

JCC will look to move toward Standards-Based Grading in the next five years.

- 1. We will explore more of the "train-the-trainer" opportunities.
- 2. Quarterly communications with neighboring districts to share/reflect on progress.
- 3. Standards-Based Grading will be piloted at various grade levels and departments.
 - a. Kindergarten in 2014-15.
 - b. Preschool and 1st Grade in 2015-16.
 - c. 2nd Grade in 2016-17.
 - d. 3rd, 4th, 5th Grade and K-5th Art, PE, and Music in 2017-18.
 - e. Subjects in 6th-12th Grades in 2018-19.
